Club Parties:

It seems like each month I have the Tiki Bar in my report. This month, James installed a new top on the bar and has expanded the seating capacity by 6 bar stools. There are additional changes to enhance the area coming this spring. Little changes here and there keep the members coming back. Shade is a big issue on both sides of the pool, I hope to address that problem in the first quarter of 2020.

Employee Christmas Fund:

Christmas is the one time of the year our members can really show just how much you appreciate how hard our staff works for you. There are 45 employees that share in the Employee Christmas Fund this year. We are taking donations for the employees until December 13th. Let's make it a Merry Christmas for them.

President's Blog

In November's "Scorecard" I wrote mostly about the main reason people join our Golf and Country Club. Naturally it's the golf that we love to play so much. But I also mentioned in the opening that there are several reasons why members seek out a club like Peridia. Several other amenities that are included with your Peridia membership provide several additional attractions. Hopefully you use them.

Back when Peridia was first built, to get additional exercise members played tennis. Originally our Club had three lighted tennis courts. Within the last 6 years, two of our courts have been made into hybrid pickle ball courts. The blue boundary lines are for pickle ball and the white lines are for tennis. It takes an adjustment to differentiate if the ball is in or out, but members have adapted nicely. You may have noticed that both tennis and pickle ball make quite a racket with more and more members. Each sport has a schedule printed in the monthly "Scorecard." Call Bill Springer @ 267-767-0020 if you need more information about either sport. At the suggestion of the Long Range Planning Committee, the Master Board is preparing a much-needed makeover to our racket facility.



Another means of exercising at Peridia is swimming. Water Aerobics classes are scheduled every weekday morning. There is a growing group of members called the Water Lilies dedicated to working out each morning. Their workouts seem pretty intense. As they exit the pool they appear to be dripping of sweat. Many members also use the pool to cool off in the summer. It's a great place to bring guests and grandkids especially if you don't have your own pool. We replaced the pool pumps this past summer and have discovered the pool's marcite surface is crumbling and collecting in our filter system. It too will get a facelift next summer.

The Dining in itself is a major attraction. Good news, it's in walking distance from your homes. Over the last 5 years, increased member usage has been a goal of the Master Board and General Manager. The hours that we are open 7 days a week have steadily brought more members and public patrons into the Club. The renovation of the Club's interior increased the flexibility for seating and types of events we can offer. Wonderful dining options created by Chef Todd have been placed on the lunch and dinner menus sparking interest in trying new entrées. Everyone appreciates the good food served at Peridia. Try it. You'll like it.

Most recently, under GM Donato's direction, the Tiki Bar located on the south side of the pool deck has become a major member magnet. There almost always seems to be members meeting poolside friends. With all the excitement about the Tiki Bar, members requested more tables and chairs, and additional shade. A revitalization of the Tiki Bar is currently in the works as you may have already noticed. There's a newly painted design on the bar's façade. There are additional Tiki improvements planned as popularity continues to grow. Check out the artistry of our Tiki members.

I have never mentioned the driving range facility we have at Peridia. You can stop in the Golf Pro Shop and buy a bag of floating golf balls to hit at our lakeside practice range. You can actually join the practice range for a yearly fee with unlimited bags of floaters. Not a bad deal if you like to practice with your irons. There are two artificial grass mats from which to hit balls. Long clubs are discouraged as there are houses within range of you big hitters. For about three years Peridia has also added a Golf Driving Cage for hitting practice balls while you're waiting to tee off. You are welcome to hit balls there for free. It's located beside the practice putting green. Practice makes perfect!

Our Spectrum Contract is also an amenity. With 649 residences here in Peridia, Spectrum offered us a bulk rate for Premium cable channels plus Internet. That bulk pricing is cheaper than standard pricing for single homes outside Peridia. Spectrum has greatly improved our package by adding Wi-Fi Internet, including router/modems, and reducing landline services to a bulk rate that is less than members are currently paying on their own. The vast majority of members will be very happy with the new bulk Spectrum package that will NOT increase our TV or Internet prices for 5 more years.


