



Driving through the neighborhood, you could see houses colorfully draped with lights and ornamental figurines for the holiday season. What a merry neighborhood!

The January Scorecard is filled with opportunities and activities for your continued entertainment in 2017. Call your friends and schedule some occasions that are up and coming. - 4. FYI: You may be seeing different workers mowing grass, trimming bushes, or mulching the common grounds of Peridia. Our current grounds crew has been short staffed for too long. It's been difficult finding new employees wanting to work hard and steady like our guys. Consequently we have hired an outside contractor to take care of the common grounds so Ray Bartels team can focus solely on the golf course. It's a win-win as better course maintenance brings more patronage to our Club and the well-groomed appearance of our neighborhood will keep us proud of Peridia, Bradenton's Premiere Executive Golf and Country Club.

Finally, here's something that puts a grin on many faces. Have you seen wagging tails, pulling on leashes dragging members around the community sidewalks? Well those tails are the smiles of delighted dogs. Members' dogs are excited to exercise their owners. It's tough work hauling humans up and down the streets of Peridia. - What can you contribute to the Master Board of Directors and the Peridia community.

Voting for these positions will take place at the Annual Meeting of the individual Component Associations. Results will be announced at the Peridia Property Owners Association, Inc. Annual Meeting, April 10, 2017.

Honey-Mustard-Glazed Salmon Steaks

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup Dijon mustard
- 1/4 cup whole-grain mustard
- 1/4 cup honey
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1 1/2 teaspoons finely chopped thyme
- Four 6-ounce skinless salmon fillets or 6- to 8-ounce salmon steaks (about 3/4 inch thick)
- Canola oil, for brushing
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground pepper

How to make this recipe

- 1. In a medium bowl, whisk the mustards with the honey, soy sauce, garlic and thyme.
- 2. Light a grill or preheat a grill pan and oil the grate or pan. Brush the salmon fillets with oil and season with salt and pepper. Grill the salmon fillets skinned side down over moderate heat for about 3 minutes. Turn and grill about 3 minutes longer, until the salmon is nearly cooked through. Generously brush both sides of the salmon with the honey mustard and grill, turning frequently, until richly glazed, about 1 minute. (For salmon steaks, grill over moderately high heat, turning once, for 4 to 5 minutes, then brush with the honey mustard, turning frequently, for 1 minute.) Transfer to a platter or plates and serve, passing the remaining honey mustard at the table.

Make ahead

The honey mustard can be refrigerated overnight.

Serve with

Steamed or grilled bok choy.

Suggested pairing

Floral, full-bodied Torrontés, a white wine from Argentina, is superb with rich, saucy seafood dishes like this salmon.


