- Business and professional experience.
- Peridia and community activities in which you are involved.
- What can you contribute to the Master Board of Directors and the Peridia community.

Voting for these positions will take place at the Annual Meeting of the individual Component Associations. Results will be announced at the Peridia Property Owners Association, Inc. Annual Meeting, April 13, 2020.
