



## **General Manager's Corner**

Governor DeSantis has moved the State of Florida to phase 2. What does this mean for Peridia?

- We will operate at no more than 75% of building capacity, while keeping appropriate social distancing which is a minimum of 6 feet separating parties.
- Tables of no more than 10 is recommended but in our restaurant, because of the spacing requirements we can only seat 4 8 tops, 2 6 tops and 7 4 tops. This floor plan will give us a total of 72 seats.
- Walk-ins are permitted but we strongly recommend "reservations only" as our business model, so that we can manage our spacing efficiently.
- Peridia will make sure that all surfaces are cleaned and disinfected after every use. We are here to make your Club the safest place for you to come to for lunch, dinner or just drinks.
- We will continue taking temperatures of everyone that enters the Clubhouse, those who have temperatures over 100 degrees will be asked to leave and will receive a letter restricting them from using any of the facilities until after they have quarantined for 14 days.
- Both the Tiki and our Terrace on the Green bars will be open for seating with an open bar stool between each member with the exception of members sitting with their spouses.

We will make every effort in maintaining a safe environment for our members while they are here enjoying their home away from home.

We are seeing a slight drop in our number of To Go orders, going from an average of 105 per day to 60 per day. This drop started shortly after the State of Florida, went to phase 2. Just after a week at phase 2, we are starting to see our To Go orders pick back up, our counts are starting to grow again and we are now back up to an average of 70 per day. Our count will probably continue to get better as the Covid-19 continues to spike. I hope this service has been a benefit to the members who want as little contact with the outside world as possible.

Resurfacing of the pool and the renovation of the pool deck is scheduled to start on July  $6^{th}$ , weather permitting. This means that if the contractor is falling behind on his present project, our project may start later than July  $6^{th}$ . The office will keep you posted on the actual closing of the pool.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.

## Peridia Golf Advisory Report to the Community July 2020

The Golf Advisory Committee was established by the Peridia Master Declarations of Covenants. Our mission is to advocate that the Peridia golf course remains a "Premier" golf course, identify and recommend improvements that will enhance the golf experience and make the course more aesthetically pleasing for our members and expanded golfing community.

There are 9 members: Ed Helmer, Mike Vagi, Janice Todd, Sandy Robarge (PLGA President), Dan Cornely, John Saum, Pat Moody, Glenn Heinrich (PMGA Representative) and Frank Grote (Master Board Representative).

We have had some members question poor mowing etiquette during play. We all need to understand that mowing must take place during play, however most of the people on the machines are not golfers and may not understand the distraction they can cause. Ray has discussed the problem with his employees, explained the proper etiquette and cautioned them to act appropriately.

Concerns have been expressed about the conditions of the sand traps. Ray and the Master Board are aware more sand could be used. Some sand will soon be added to the worst offending sand traps, however complete reconditioning will not take place until next summer when other course projects are done.

Brian will also be advising the community, but worth noting is that Pro Shop Credits, which normally would have expired by now, will be carried over until 2021 due to the havoc the virus caused us all.


