
Lunch & a Book Book Club meets on the 2n

Completed Projects:

- All of our parking spaces have been painted.
- Four handicap spaces have been added to the south end of the parking lot.
- New netting around the warm up cage has been installed.
- The curbs at the intersection of Murfield Drive and Peridia Blvd. have been painted.
- The Pro Shop exterior has been painted.
- New ceiling fans have installed outside the Pro Shop.
- The landscaping has been replaced along the north end of cart barn.
- New landscaping has been added to the south side of the tennis courts.

Projects still on the board to complete this summer:




