
This event points out some good reminders for all of us. Don't open your door to strangers. Direct inquiries about houses that are for sale to the realtor. Never provide any information about the owner or their whereabouts.

Take note of strangers walking around houses. It is not recommended that you confront these people yourselves but that you call the sheriff's office and report it. They will come out and assess the situation. If the individual arrived in a vehicle and you can see the license plate from inside your house, provide it to the police. Do not go outside and make yourself a target.

In this case, the camera and the neighbor were able to provide significant details to the police. Staying alert to what's going on around you can make the difference between catching the crooks and being a victim. Keep your eyes open and please report anything suspicious or out of place to the police! Help keep Peridia safe!

## Recipe of the Month

In a separate bowl, whisk together the mayonnaise, mustard, pickled relish, and salt and pepper to taste. Add the dressing to the macaroni and toss to coat. Cover and chill for 2 hours.
