I hope that everyone enjoyed the winter season and had a chance to play in the great conditions we had at our Golf Course. A big thanks to Ray and his staff for the hard work in keeping Peridia in tip-top shape. This is the time for our maintenance season to kick in as well, so please make sure you look at the schedule posted in the Golf Shop for closure dates and times.

The Golf Course will be closed all Mondays through August. The PLGA will continue starting on Tuesday's at 8:30AM and will be a shotgun start. The PMGA will be a 8:00AM shotgun start on Wednesday's starting June 6. Please call the Golf Shop if you have any questions.

For those members still here that play golf in the summertime, please make sure you stop in the Golf Shop to pick up your list of golf courses that we have a reciprocal agreement with. These are courses outside of Peridia that you can play for a discounted greens fee. Please make sure you look at each course's ground rules for making tee times.

Etiquette 101: This month I would like to talk about etiquette on the putting green. Players should not stand on another player's line of putt or, when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt. Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the group have holed out.

As a reminder, the Golf Course will have an entire new irrigation system installed this summer. The schedule is set from June 11 - September 11. Nine holes will be closed at a time with nine holes remaining open for play. My normal summer maintenance such as; aerification, nematicide application, as well as fertilizing will all be dependent on having water. So at this point there is no set schedule for these events. I apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may have. This summer's project is a necessary evil, needed to update a 30 year old inefficient irrigation system.

General Manager's Column

The Clubs' financials for the first 4 months of 2018 are showing that our Members are using their Club. Our revenues for the first four months of 2018 are at \$1,410,639; this is \$32,648 ahead of budget. Our Cost of Goods Sold for that same period is \$163,736 which is \$3,966 better then budget. On the expense side, we have spent \$883,036 which is \$7,341 over budget Year to Date. Our Net Income before Depreciation and Capital Transfer is \$363,867, which is \$29,273 ahead of Budget. Our rounds of golf are up by 316 over last year at this same time. The restaurant covers are about the same as last year.

June 11, 2018 is the date that construction will start on the irrigation system for the Golf Course. The plan is to start on number 10 and work their way back to the Clubhouse. Mondragon has started their staging; the pipe for the first 9 holes has been delivered along with the sprinkler heads. Most of the equipment will be delivered on Monday June 4, the office trailer will be located on the Northeast corner of the Clubhouse parking lot.

I have asked Ray to set up the front 9 with two pin placements so that you will be playing the red course and gold course. What we are trying to do is give the golfer 18 different pin placements and some distant changes so that the feel is that you are playing 18 holes rather than the same 9 holes twice.

Update on the weir is that after the first rain the flow of water thru the system was great but since then the silt that is on the bottom of the lake has moved to the top of the filtering system and has clogged the system to the point that there is very little water flowing through and out the weir. The design and the construction of the weir is not the problem. The problem is the storm water drain pipe coming into the lake from Augusta Terrace. The water that is draining off Augusta Terrace is draining into the lake just in front of the weir system and stirring the silt up from the bottom to the top, then the silt does not have enough time to settle back down to the bottom before reaching the weir's filtering system. The silt that is on the top of the water floats over and onto the top of the filtering system which is clogging the drain field. Mr. Handy and I are working with Tim Dove, the engineer, to find a way to redirect the flow of the water from Augusta Terrace entering into the lake. If we can find a way to stop the disturbance of the silt which allow the silt to remain on the bottom of the lake allowing the clean water to flow through the system as it was designed to do. We hope to have an answer or solution by the end of next month.

The Club House committee has had their second meeting with Sarah Colandor (Fawley Bryant). At this meeting, the committee selected the chairs and tables for the lobby. They are still undecided on the fabric for those chairs. The carpet for the restaurant and the flooring for the entry and dance floor have been finalized. Our next meeting should be coming together this next week to finalize the restaurant chairs and fabric. There have been discussions about removing the elevated dance floor and the platform on the south side of the room. This will give the room an open-air concept and a feel that the room is bigger. We have the General Contractor giving us a price on the demolition, we will then know if this can be done within our budget.

At our last Board Meeting, I was asked to re-write the dress code for Peridia and the staff here at Peridia will be enforcing the Dress Code with a smile. President's Blog

Are you a superstitious golfer? If you follow any of these superstitions, you might improve your game.



- 1. Use a lucky ball.
- 2. Wear the same lucky socks or hat for each round.
- 3. If in doubt, use your lucky club.
- "Splast 4. Don't use water balls on holes with water hazards. You'll think it in the water.
- 5. Never use a red tee. Psychologically it'll make you swing too aggressively.
- 6. Don't wash off a ball if you're having a great round.
- Always wear a red/pink shirt for the final round of a tournament. (Tiger Woods/Paula Creamer) 7.
- Believe in the power of threes. Tom Weiskopf constantly carried three cents and three tees in his 8. pocket.
- Jack Nicklaus also carries three coins in his pocket with every round of golf. 9.
- 10. Don't forget about the "birdie ball." Every ball naturally only has one birdie in it. Once your ball has hit that birdie, time to switch to a new ball. (Ernie Els)
- 11. Use golf balls that are numbered lower than five. You'll always score lower than that on any hole. (Ben Crenshaw)
- 12. Zach Johnson carries a ball marker that has biblical words that he reads during a round. His wife gave it to him.
- 13. John Cook marks his golf ball with a quarter that has a picture of a state where he played well in a tournament. Lucky ball markers are just as important as a lucky club.
- 14. Paul Azinger on the other hand marks his golf ball with a penny with the head of Abraham Lincoln looking at the hole.
- 15. Never use a penny as a marker. It cheapens the game. If you use a coin, always put it head side up. (Chi-Chi Rodriguez)
- 16. Davis Love III uses only 1965 or 1966 pennies to marks his ball on the green. Any other years would bring him bad luck. He also only uses white tees. Some pros think white tees are unlucky and will never use them.
- 17. Flip a coin before marking your ball on the green. Mark your ball with the side that lands upward. If it's tails, mark the ball with the tail facing up in a normal fashion. If it's heads, make sure the head is facing the hole. The head always has to be in the right place. (Fred Funk)
- 18. Step on a crack will break your mother's back. Step on the edge, straight into the hedge. Stepping on the edge where the fairway meets the green will bring you bad luck. (Christina Kim)
- 19. Driving a golf cart while using a cell phone will make it 23 times more likely to end the round sooner than expected with a big splash and no chance to sink your putt.
