From the Pro Shop

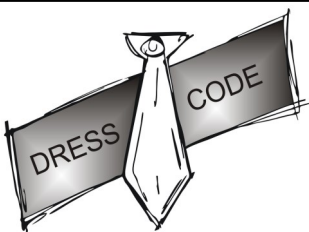

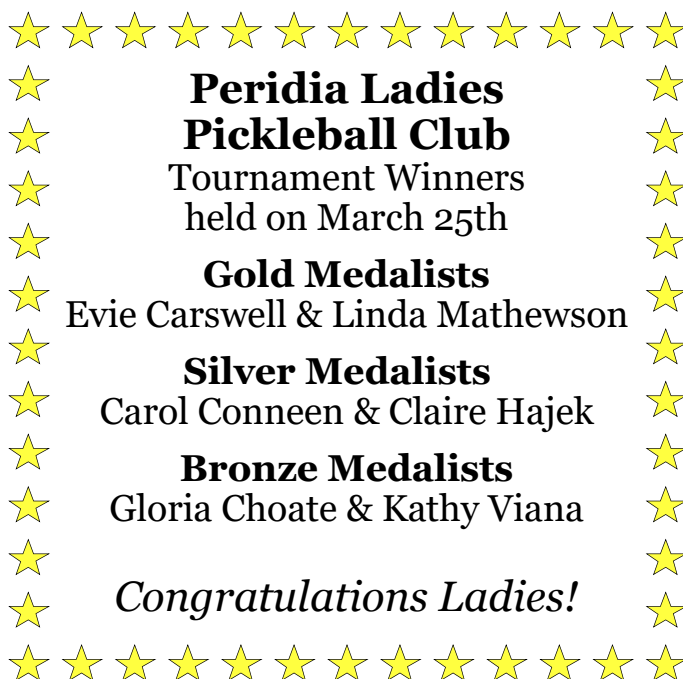

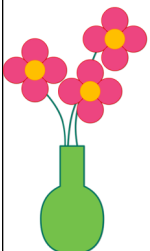

General Manager's Corner

The golf course has started its annual transition from winter rye grass back to Bermuda grass. During the transition you will notice some thin areas in our fairways. These thin areas are a result of heavy traffic as they are every season. Getting those areas back will take some time but Ray and his staff will start aerifying and verticutting during the next couple of weeks. This maintenance routine will be done early in the mornings before our golfers hit the links. If he needs to do additional work in those areas, Ray will work between our members play. The areas should be back to normal by mid-June.

Mondragon has finished the drainage improvements on most of the front nine and now they have moved to the back nine. They should finish the back nine within two weeks. They have not begun to improve the drainage ditch on hole number 3 as of yet, but it is part of the plan. Shortly after the drainage work is completed, Mondragon will resume work on our bulkhead replacement project.

This summer we will be closing the golf course on Thursdays each week beginning May 27th and we will re-open on Thursday, October 7th. By closing the golf course one day week, Ray has one day each week to perform golf course maintenance and improvements without interfering with our member's play.

Cart path repair work will start in July. This work will take approximately two to three weeks to complete and we ask for patience and cooperation from our members during this project. The contractor will be transporting materials between member's homes using small buggies so that there will be no damage to member's yards.

A representative from York Bridge Construction Company was here in April to assess the condition of the bridge on hole #18. His comments were that the bridge was solid but needed a face lift. His recommendation was to replace the railings and install a new driving surface. His company is not interested in remodeling, but if we do end up completely replacing the bridge, he would be happy to quote a number. Our plan at this time is to follow the recommendation, obtain a contractor and develop a plan for the bridge face lift.

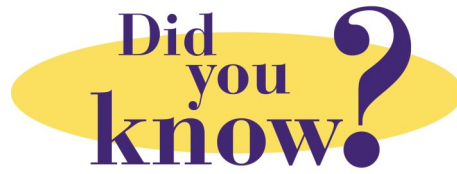
Sand trap improvement is scheduled for September. Our plan is to have a fresh look with new sand being added to the traps just before the start of the season. We have five traps needing about eight inches of sand and the other traps will only need about four inches. The drainage in all of the traps is working as it was designed to do.

The storm that came thru on April 10th around 6:00PM blew a lot of the fencing away from the poles on the tennis/pickle ball courts. This was due to the wind screens that are attached to the fence not allowing the air to flow through freely. The wiring of the fencing, which is designed to break away before the poles bend, did exactly what it was designed to do when we have heavy winds. Frank and James are currently working on the repairs. Those of you that were here that night got to witness the wind as it came very close to blowing our shade canopies off the pool deck. I think we were very lucky that night not to have a lot more damage to our outside facilities.

Our Tiki bar hours, Monday thru Sunday 11:00AM to dusk, will remain the same thru this off season with management keeping an eye on revenues and expenses. We will be monitoring member usage as this will be our first summer season with the Tiki bar open. The Tavern on the Green will be closed each Thursday starting May 27th and will re-open for Thursdays on October 7th. The kitchen will also be closed on those same Thursdays, so there will be no food service for to-go orders or for the Tiki bar.

Fighting Fraud and Staying Safe

AARP recently reported that frauds aimed at older adults are becoming more creative. Scammers stay on top of whatever is new, such as the popularity of Zoom, COVID-19 Vaccine Card Cons, fake online shopping sites, and “account problem calls or texts”. There are many more however, but these are some of the latest. If you receive an e-mail or message with the Zoom logo telling you to click on the link because your account is suspended, etc., do not do it. If you click, it can allow criminals to download malicious software onto your computer and access your personal information. Many who got a COVID vaccine posted selfies showing their vaccine card and the scammers immediately pounced on that. If you want to inform friends and family that you got your shots, do so, but do not post your card on social media. Do, however, keep it in a safe place and making a copy of it is suggested as well. Some doctor’s offices are making them a part of your medical records and will accept a copy for their records, and moving forward, the original card may be required for travel, cruises, entry into other countries. Who knows!! Fake on-line sites are using phony logos that closely resemble the real ones. Never click on an ad to go to a retailer website. Scammers are sending fake text messages or calling, pretending to be your credit card company or your bank to advise that there is a problem with your account, or someone has tried to access it through an ATM. Do not give them any information, just contact your bank or credit card company to check for a problem. Lastly, let calls from numbers you do not recognize go to voice mail. Delete suspicious pop-ups or phone messages. Do not allow anyone remote access to your home computer unless it is the Geek Squad or similar company that you have contacted for help with a problem.

Staying Safe: Well, that has an entirely new meaning than it used to, that is for sure!! It seems the older we get, the more challenges we face, not just medically but emotionally as well. 2020 sucked and while we are seeing some light at the end of the tunnel (hopefully it’s not a train!) we are beginning to enjoy the outside, visits with loved ones, dinners by the ocean and at our beautiful Country Club and Tiki Bar. For some of us we can breathe a little easier now that we have had our vaccinations. We aren’t out of the woods for sure, but hopefully we are moving in the right direction. 
