#### From the Golf Course Superintendent By Raymond Bartels, CGCS

On behalf of me and the maintenance crew, welcome back and I hope you have enjoyed your summer. As you know we were very busy implementing a new irrigation system on the Golf Course. There are a few smaller zones being installed off to the sides of rough areas and lakes. The project should be completed, as well as some temporary repairs to #3 headwall, by mid month. You will notice some trench and plow lines still growing in, this was expected going into the project. The lines out in the rough areas will be on going for a few months. The trench and plow lines around the approaches, fairways and tees will be covered with winter overseed and should not hinder play once seed is established. Speaking of winter overseed, on Tuesday, November 13 & Wednesday, November 14, the course will be closed at 12:00 to apply winter overseed. On Thursday, November 15, the course will be closed all day for pesticides, fertilizers as well as more overseed.

The course will be Cart Paths only Friday, November 16, Saturday, November 17 and Sunday, November 18. These cart path only days will not completely stop the tracking off of the overseed

to unwanted areas but will help minimize it. The lake on hole 12 and half of the south lake on hole 15 are being repaired with the geo-tube restoration. Enjoy the course and I am looking forward

to seeing you out there.

#### **Table Lotteries for Member Events: How They Work and Why**

From October thru April we are fortunate to have most of our members residing in Florida, enjoying the beautiful weather and companionship of their neighbors and friends. During this time our member parties fill to capacity, with others on a wait list wishing to attend. Having a lottery allows us to get an immediate count of those planning to attend, and the size of tables needed to make those accommodations. When everyone has signed in, giving the number of guests at their table, we can customize the floor plan to maximize seating to allow as many as possible to get the size table they require.

When you see an event you wish to attend, come into the office and pick up an event sign up sheet. On the top, fill in the name and date of the event. List the names, and member numbers of those who will be at the table you are hosting. Please list only people who have confirmed that they will be attending with you. On the bottom give the name and phone number of the contact person for this table.

We will always have a friendship table, where singles or couples who wish to attend and meet other members are welcome to join. Please fill out an event sheet prior to the lottery and indicate that you wish to be at the friendship table and leave it in the office. You do not need to attend the lottery to join a friendship table.

The day of the lottery, before the designated time, bring in your list, sign your name and the number of guests at your table on the sheet provided. Fold your list and deposit it in the container. All guests will pay for themselves the evening of the event.

All lotteries will be held in the north end of the lounge to allow seating for those attending the lottery. The lottery will start at the designated time. If you or someone at your table cannot attend the lottery, you can leave the slip in the office and we will select your table as a proxy.

The first member events this season, we had members who wished to attend that we could not accommodate, because we were full. Unfortunately, the evening of the event, seats sat empty, because people who were signed up to attend did not call ahead to let us know they would not be coming. This results in lost revenue and is unfair to those who were on a wait list to attend. The Club's policy is to charge those members who signed up for an event but did not attend nor cancel.

By now most of our snowbirds have returned and it is wonderful to see you all again. You will find many new neighbors have joined our community since you left so make sure you get to know your new neighbors when you have time!

Staying healthy also means staying safer so I want to remind everyone to get their flu shot. The CDC reports that last year over 12,000 people over the age of 65 died from the flu. The flu virus is constantly changing so they update the vaccines accordingly. While it's not 100% effective, it does decrease our chances of getting the flu. Also, make sure you are up to date on your pneumonia vaccine.

Spam calls/robo calls and other unwanted phone calls continue to surge. Even with efforts to curb them in the first four months of this year over 12 billion robocalls were made to American homes!! That's because they work for the crooks and people continue to send them money. You can try not picking up but when the calls reach your voicemail greeting, it flags that yours is a working number. A few things that have been proven effective in reducing them on your cell phone is using the app that your phone company provides. AT&T can use Call Protect, Verizon provides Caller Name ID and T-Mobile has Scam ID and Scam Block. Another 'freebie' for landline users is \*77 which blocks anonymous and private numbers. You can deactivate that anytime with \*87.

The entrances off 45<sup>th</sup> Street remain congested due to the widening project which will be on-going into 2019, so use extra care when utilizing that entrance/exit. Some people have reported tire damage due to construction debris in the road. The apartment construction continues but is currently not impeding traffic at our main entrance. There is a dental office being built at the office park, but excavation and exterior work appears to be mostly complete. I do not have a completion date for the apartments but suspect it will be the first half of 2019.

Recently, one of our residents was surprised to find a stranger in her garage. The police responded quickly, but the culprit had already left. 


