Happy October everyone!! I hope all of you that have returned and are returning from up North and those of you that have been in Florida have had an excellent summer.

Golf Etiquette Section: This month I want to talk about Blue Flag rules and regulations. Golf Carts that use blue flags may drive to within 10 feet in front of the greens and tee boxes. A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and the next tee box except on holes 7, 8 and 18 where you may drive on the rough to the tee markers. A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and sand traps. Also, no blue flags will be issued when cart path only is in effect. Driving carts too close to greens and tees will result in compaction problems. We want to keep Peridia and its Golf Course in great condition and this is one way to do that.

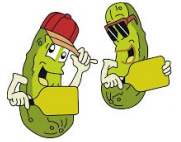

General Manager's Corner

Electrical Upgrade: Due to Hurricane Dorian, FPL canceled our scheduled electrical upgrade from the 4th and 5th of September to the 7th and 8th of October. The Clubhouse will be closed those two days due to the power outage. Bay Area Electric will be working on the new gear box to get us up and running shortly after FPL completes their upgrade.

Acoustics Panels: The panels for the lounge have been delivered. James and Frank will be hanging them on Monday, October 7 during the time the Clubhouse is closed. As soon as the panels have been installed, I will start taking decibel readings to measure the reduction in noise and give the BOD an update at our October meeting.

Pool Repair: Galaxy Pools finished with the filtering system on September 5th, we had the county inspection two days later, which we passed. We are up and running.

The painting of pool deck is scheduled to be finished this week, James and Frank painted half of the deck during the pool shutdown but were not able to finish the painting due to all the rain and the requirement to complete other time sensitive projects. They are back to painting the deck and it should be finished by the time you read this update.

The Golf Pro Shop bathrooms have been completed and they are now open for the golfers to use. They turned out nice, James still has some painting to do on the walls as you go in to the bathrooms, he should have that completed soon.

The pool bath has been completed and is open. Kevin from Design SRQ Tile recommended the porcelain tile for the floor because it is a non-slip product when wet, but after I stepped on a wet spot and slipped, I then ordered a non-slip product for the tile. It was applied this past Saturday and I tested it this morning and I did not slip. I will keep my eye on it and if needed I will have James put another coat down. I am sure that the Water Lilies will let me know if it gets slippery again. Right Ladies?

The curfew application, for our control of nematodes and mole crickets, went down without a hitch on the 18th. There was no damage to the course due to the big tractors that injected the chemical. Ray fertilized the whole Golf Course on the 25th right after the PMGA finished their play. He then aerified the greens the next day with ¼ inch by 3-inch tines. I know it seems like we have a lot of course maintenance taking place all at once but during the 7 weeks that we received 36-inches of rain, it put our normal schedule way behind. Getting all of this done this last week has put us back on schedule and for our over seeding in November.

The lake banks on holes 6 and 15 have been completed. They look good.

The windscreens for the tennis courts were taken down thinking that Dorian was going to come across the state. Dorian fooled us and the windscreens have not been put back up. We have a line of storms in the Atlantic so there is no sense in putting them back up until the Atlantic settles down again.

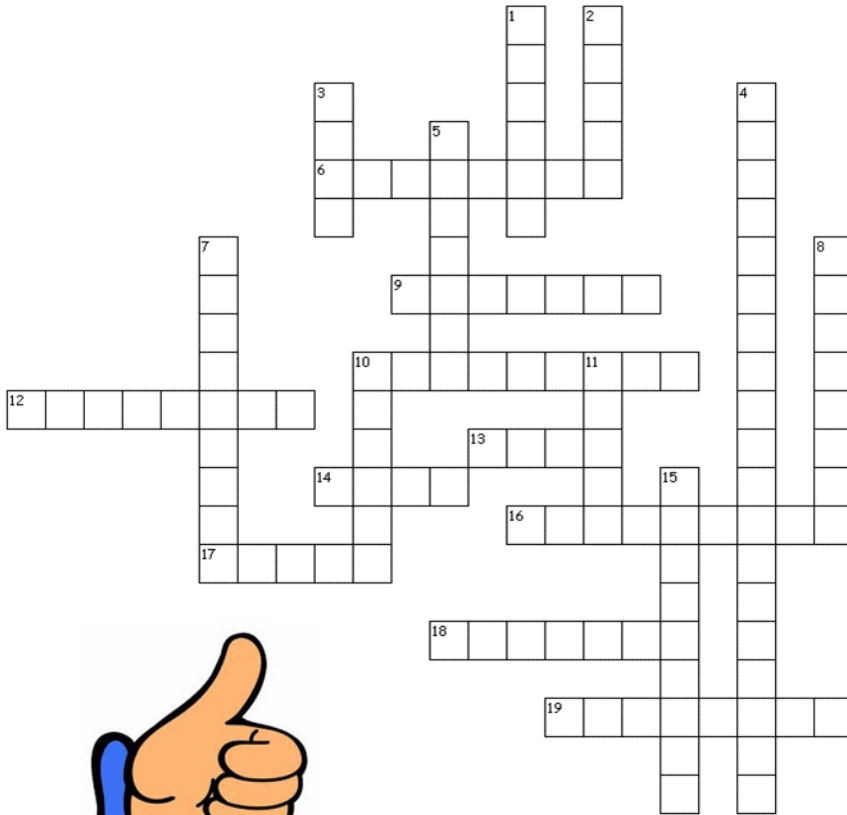

You do not have to be a member of the DAV or any other Veterans Service Organization to take advantage of the use of this equipment. If you are in need of this type of equipment, please contact Peridia member Jerry Krallman at 941-779-4613. We can deliver the equipment to you. However, we do not have ramps for you to get wheel chairs in a van or pick-up.

The DAV also operates a Service Office at 111 63rd Ave East. Our Service Officers receive 40 hours of training annually and are certified to file your forms with the VA. This office is manned Monday – Friday from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM and can be contacted at 941-752-2900. If you think you have a service connected injury or disease we will assist you in filing all VA forms to see if you qualify for service related disability compensation or an increase in compensation. Again, this is at no charge and you do not have to be a member. We mention this because the VA recently made the presumptive diseases associated with Agent Orange available to veterans who served off the shore of Vietnam (the Blue Water Navy). Compensation for similar presumptive diseases are approved for contaminated water for anyone who served at Camp Lejeune for 30 cumulative days between the dates of Aug 1, 1953 to Dec 31, 1987.



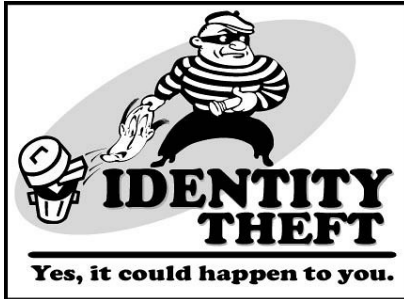

PROTECT YOUR IDENTITY

First of all, Welcome Back to all our snowbirds. We have missed you during the summer, but most days those of us who stay here year-round were "wishing we had a place up North too!" The heat was oppressive, but as usual we got used to it; plus, the rain seemed as though it would never stop. I swear I saw a boat going down Presidential with two giraffes in the back.....

We are all disappointed that 45th Street hasn't been completed yet, but the rain extended the project, which currently is supposed to be completed by the end of Sept. except for the lake which will be on-going for a while longer. There will not be a fence around the lake. Please continue to use caution on 45th. It is very confusing when entering from 70 or Lockwood Ridge, if you are unfamiliar with it. When completed the speed limit will be 45 MPH.



I talk about identify theft and scams often in this column because the crooks are coming up with new ways to scam us every day. Identity theft is the number one crime in America. Make sure that you are shredding any documents that contain your personal information such as SSN, bank account numbers, credit card statements, pre-approved applications and medical related information. Even the labels on our pill bottles and the prescription bags that they come in have our personal information embedded into the bar code. This has been an ongoing practice for many years, but only in the last few years have the crooks figured this out (most likely with the help of someone who worked in a medical office or pharmacy). When you throw the pill bottles and/or the bags out, take a black magic marker and cover up the bar code information!

Social Security does not have a call center, nor does Microsoft or Apple. They will not call you. If you receive a call from them, hang up immediately. It is a good idea to obtain a copy of your credit report at least once a year and to provide the 3 credit bureaus with a death certificate of a loved one.

We recently had an incident where a car traveling fast down Peridia Blvd. appeared to be 'aiming' for a walker and then turned away at the last minute. Please pay attention to your surroundings and report anything suspicious.

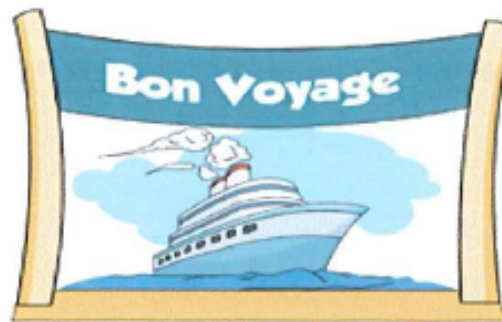

Recipe of the Month

Warm-Me-Up Chicken Chili

INGREDIENTS:

2 tbs. olive oil or vegetable oil
2 lbs. skinless, boneless chicken breast halves
or thighs, cut into 1-inch pieces
1 large onion, chopped (1 cup)
2 celery stalks, chopped (1 cup)
1 large green or red sweet pepper, seeded & chopped (1 cup)
2 medium yellow banana peppers or poblano chile peppers,
seeded & chopped*** (1 cup)
3 medium cloves garlic, minced



2 tablespoons ground cumin
1 tablespoon chili powder
1 tablespoon dried oregano, crushed
1/2-3/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 28 - ounce or two 15-ounce cans tomato puree
2 14 1/2 - ounce cans diced tomatoes
1 15-16 - ounce can black beans, rinsed & drained
1 15-16 - ounce can pinto beans or dark red
kidney beans, rinsed & drained

DIRECTIONS:

In a 5- or 6-quart Dutch oven, heat the oil over medium-high heat. Add half of the chicken pieces; cook and stir for 4 to 5 minutes or until no longer pink. Remove with a slotted spoon. Repeat with remaining chicken. To the Dutch oven, add onion, celery, sweet pepper, banana peppers and garlic. Cook for 5 to 6 minutes or until the onion is tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in cumin, chili powder, oregano, crushed red pepper and salt. Cook and stir for 2 minutes more. Return chicken to the Dutch oven. Add tomato puree and undrained tomatoes to Dutch oven; stir to combine. Bring to boiling; reduce heat. Simmer, covered, for 30 minutes, stirring occasionally. Stir in the drained black and pinto beans. Simmer, covered, for 10 minutes more. Season to taste...YUM.
