Golf Etiquette Section: This month I want to talk about Blue Flag rules and regulations. Golf Carts that use blue flags may drive to within 10 feet in front of the greens and tee boxes. A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and the next tee box except on holes 7, 8 and 18 where you may drive on the rough to the tee markers. A blue flag does not allow you to drive between the green and sand traps. Also, no blue flags will be issued when cart path only is in effect. Driving carts too close to greens and tees will result in compaction problems. We want to keep Peridia and its Golf Course in great condition and this is one way to do that.



Members: Please remember our Dress Code when bringing guests to the Clubhouse.

Casual Country Club attire is acceptable for regular dining. Acceptable attire includes blouses for women, collared shirts for men, golf shirts, knit tops, khaki pants or walking shorts, slacks or skirts. Jeans are discouraged.



General Manager's Corner

I sat down and took a look back at my last couple of monthly messages and found them to be very boring! Each month has been all about what is going on at the Club. Way too much detail of the Club's operation to date. Well, guess what???...This GM Message is also boring! This message is also about what is going on at the Club. I promise as we get past the few projects that we are working on, I will get back to the lighter side of my personality and bring back those smiles. So, here we go with my last boring message for this year.

TENNIS/PICKELBALL:

The Tennis/Pickleball courts are coming along even though the rain just won't stop. Taylor construction has been working on the low spots and getting them leveled. The pickleball netting and posts have been delivered. We should be playing pickleball and tennis by the 3rd of October. We now have a Tennis/Pickleball committee that will advise me on their needs and give the BOD an update on the condition of the courts when needed. They are asking for benches, shade and netting. The netting for separating the tennis courts from the pickleball courts will cost about \$600 and another \$100 for the posts and concrete. Three shade units' size 10×4 , total \$1,600. Two benches total \$500. Total \$2,300.

POOL DECK and TIKI BAR:

The pool has been resurfaced and the deck will be complete this week. Staff will be out cleaning and stocking the Tiki Bar to get ready for our opening on October 5th. That's right Monday, October the 5th at 11:00AM the Tiki Bar will be open. The Pool will be open for our Members too!

EARLY MORNING GOLF COURSE NOISE:

We are now starting our tee times at 7:42AM and our shotgun starts are at 8:30AM. As we get into the season the 7:42AM tee times will continue but the shotgun starts will go to 9:00AM. This is due to the increased number of players which will push the shotguns back to hole #15, this is all due to us not being able to mow before 7:00AM. Mr. Roell has been in contact with Commissioner Baugh explaining to her that our interpretation of the ordinance, does not pertain to golf course maintenance in Manatee County. The commissioner has responded by saying that she has passed his interpretation off to the legal department. We hope to get a favorable response soon.


CLUB OPERATIONS:

On the golf side for the month of August our rounds were up by 482 over August 2019. Our members rounds were 429 of the 482. The golf department beat their budget by \$10,402 for August. Good job Brian and staff.

The food and beverage department missed their budget by (\$19,507), although our TO-GO's are averaging 48 a day, our dine-in covers were 581 and Banquet covers were 162 for August. Our department heads squeezed on the expense side coming in under budget by \$38,355, giving us total saving to budget of \$34,317 for the month of August. YTD the Club is ahead of budget by \$144,199. As we get into the last four months of the year our monthly revenue forecasts are a lot higher and will be much harder for the department heads to offset those losses just through squeezing our expenses. You have a great staff here at Peridia and fortunately they understand BOTTOM LINE. You can help the Club with its revenue by ordering TO-GO dinners once a week.

Remember, I always have time for your questions or comments, so please stop by my office. My door is always open.

Here are a couple of items from the summer and a general account of how we used the Club this summer.

Did you know that the food drive held at Peridia was a huge success? Organized by Susan Lane, thirty volunteers delivered empty sacks to each residence. A few days later they collected these sacks now filled with groceries. A total of 3762 pounds of food was donated. In addition, \$1055 in cash was given. All of this was delivered to the Manatee County Food Bank. Thanks to all for stepping up when so many were truly in need. And thank you, Susan!.

Another way Peridians have always stepped up is by giving blood. Drives are scheduled throughout the year and an extra date was added this summer. Thanks to Carol Milling for coordinating this effort. The next blood drive is scheduled for November 10.

Use of the golf course has been very good over the summer months. The 4th of July outing was well supported by the membership with 83 golfers participating and 93 enjoying lunch at the Club. The Labor Day outing was equally successful with 80 people enjoying golf and lunch. Brian Schmidt reports that for the months of June, July and August we had 1158 more rounds played than in the comparable months in 2019.

Four bingos were held over the last three months. Attendance ranged from a low of 48 to a high of 65. The use of the restaurant and the take out service remained steady. Just over 90 meals a day are being served by the restaurant.

A big thank you goes to all members for USING THE CLUB this summer. Because of you our financial health remains very good.

Next month I plan to give a full report on the renovation of the tennis/pickleball courts.

WELCOME BACK TO OUR NORTHERN FRIENDS! Hoping you had a good summer (or at least made the best of it given our current situation). We had an extremely hot summer with little rain (until it started raining in late August and seems like it rained non-stop for a while). Recently, we got over 4 inches of rain in a short period of time and had the most flooding that I have seen in Peridia in the 8 years we have been here. Many people got stranded and several cars required towing. Unfortunately, on Murfield, residents of a nearby neighborhood drove through people's yards instead of parking in a drive way until it subsided. Manatee County has issued the following statement regarding driving on flooded roads:

Never drive through water than you cannot see the bottom/road through. It could have been opened up into a hole larger than your car or it could stall your car and cause damage. Fortunately, when the rain stopped, the water went away very quickly but left a lot of debris and caused some damage to vehicles.

The county continues to have cars broken into that are left unlocked outside. I think Peridia residents are doing a great job of securing their vehicles, but just a reminder to remember to lock it when you get out. Several neighborhoods have reported that thieves have been entering open garage doors during the day and unlocking the side door and then returning during the night and removing items from the garage. So please remember to keep your garage doors closed.

Our Fire Station #4 (45th St E) has a new paramedic response engine. It has a 24 hrs. a day firefighter-paramedic on board to respond and treat advanced critical care patients prior to EMS arriving. This is good news for our area for sure.

The phone scams just continue to multiply. Recently they have been COVID-19 related scams with someone asking for your personal information to verify if you have been associated with someone that has tested positive. If a tracer does call, they will not ask for your social security number, banking info, etc. Just don't answer the phone if you do not recognize the number and if you do, immediately hang up when you determine it to be a Robo call.

If you recently returned you will see that there is quite a bit of construction continuing in our area of the county. This includes 92 new apartment units at 33rd and SR70, Firestone Tire & Car Repair Store behind the Neighborhood Walmart, an oil change place being built next to our new Wendy's, a new Winn Dixie is replacing Earth Fare in LWR and another apartment complex has been approved at Lockwood Ridge and Whitfield just to name a few. Unfortunately, some of the restaurants and retailers have closed for good since you left as well as a lot of bank branches. Bank of America's Peridia Branch does not have plans at this time to re-open, but the branch at Tara has remained open. The continuation of 44th St E to Lakewood Ranch is on-going and will continue for quite some time. Construction type traffic is very heavy too. We have quite a few new residents that have moved in since May, which is good for Peridia. Hopefully as season gets underway, we will get to welcome them to our wonderful neighborhood.


